Our guest speaker at the Installation Dinner was Sarah Teacher, Executive Director of the Impact Investing Institute.

Sarah spoke passionately about GIM being “respectful of tradition” but also being “agents of change in this vital and important industry”.

The Impact Investing Institute was founded in 2019 with a mission to change capital markets so they are fairer and work better for people and planet, and to encourage financial products that mitigate climate change, reduce inequality, and protect the natural environment, as well as make a compelling financial return.

At the recent Finance for Impact Summit, hosted by the City of London Corporation at Mansion House (opened and closed by the Lord Mayor) and held in association with the Impact Investing Institute, we heard about the launch of the **Just Transition Finance Challenge**, and that 18 founding participants will have a ‘Just Transition’ financing product by next year.
